A note about reflection journals: A common tendency is for journal entries to become a mere log of events rather than a reflective activity in which students consider the service experience in the context of learning objectives. Guidance is needed to help students link personal learning with course content.

How to Write a Journal Entry | Examples

Students need to write their individual reflective journal concurrently with performing assessment tasks 1 and 2, i.e. from the first week of the subject. For each week, students need to make journal entries that provide a reflection of their ‘journey’ of gaining, and applying knowledge of the research paradigm.

Here are three examples of journal entries written for an introductory philosophy course, all based on a single passage by Lao Tzu, a Chinese philosopher who lived in the sixth century B.C. During your student teaching semester, reflection will become an important part of the growth process. Sometimes reflection is informal and sometimes it is more formal, such as a discussion or written entry.
